FANJEAUX SUMMER STUDY

May 30 – June 12, 2022 Faculty and Staff Grant Application

In partnership with our sister institutions, Dominican University provides the opportunity for one faculty and one staff member to participate in the Dominican Colleges and Universities Summer Study trip to the lands of St. Dominic. University support will include coverage of the \$2700 fee for attendance (including all excursions, ground transportation, room and board for 12 days in Carcassonne, and a farewell dinner), + \$500 grant toward the purchase of the plane fare. Participation in this seminar has been transformative for past grant recipients. It allowed them to explore areas where St. Dominic ministered and founded the Order of Preachers. It also gave a deeper understanding of the Dominican charism and mission as it is lived out at Dominican University.

Eligibility

In order to apply for the grant, individuals must be either:

- a staff member who has been actively employed at full-time or PT30 status for at least three years; administrators and cabinet members qualify in this category as well.
- a tenure-track faculty member who has been employed at full-time status for at least three years.

Applications Process

In 300-500 words, please write a letter of application that addresses the following questions:

- Why are you interested in participating in the Fanjeaux Summer Study?
- How do feel attending this seminar will influence your work here at Dominican?
- How will your attendance enhance your understanding of the University mission?

Staff members applying for the grant must also submit a letter of support from their immediate supervisor indicating pre-approval for absence from work from May 30 - June 12,2022.

All applications will be reviewed by the Vice President for Mission and Planning, Claire Noonan, and a committee of faculty and staff who have made the pilgrimage previously. The committee will send its recommendations to the university President Glena Temple who will make the final selection among candidates and invite participation.
