I have read Dominican University's *Federal TEACH Grant Information Sheet* and am aware of the following conditions of the TEACH Grant:

- An Application for Federal TEACH Grant Consideration must be submitted to the Dominican University Financial Aid Office and the student must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each academic year that the student applies for the grant.
- TEACH Grant recipients must be U.S. Citizens or eligible non citizens.
- TEACH Grant recipients must be enrolled in a program of study designated as TEACH Grant eligible.
- TEACH Grant recipients must maintain a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.25 (on a 4.0 scale) on college coursework to receive the grant for each subsequent term.
- The student must complete the U.S. Department of Education's Initial and Subsequent Counseling before completing the Agreement to Serve (ATS). Counseling must be completed at the website: <u>https://studentaid.gov</u> each academic year that the student is applying for the Grant. Dominican University must have confirmation that Counseling has been completed before the grant will be awarded.
- The student must complete a TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve (ATS) each academic year that the student is receiving the TEACH Grant. Dominican University must have confirmation that the Agreement to Serve has been completed before the Grant will be awarded. The student will receive more information about completing an ATS at the website: https://studentaid.gov
- TEACH Grant recipients must serve as a highly qualified, full time teacher in a high need field in a public or private elementary or secondary school that serves low income students.
- TEACH Grant recipients must teach for at least four academic years within eight calendar years of completing or withdrawing from the program of study for which the TEACH Grant was received.
- If the teaching service obligation is not met, all amounts of the TEACH Grant that were awarded to the student will be converted to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan. This loan must be repaid to the U.S. Department of Education. Interest will be charged from the date the grant(s) was disbursed.
- Enrollment is reviewed at the start of each term. Students enrolled full time in a term may be eligible for up to \$2,000 for that term, students enrolled less than full time in a term will be eligible for a pro-rated amount.
- Dominican University only offers the TEACH Grant to students pursuing a Master's Degree.
