



RN-BSN Program Financial Aid

FAFSA Completion:

Students must complete the FAFSA each year in order to be eligible for federal financial aid.

Complete the FAFSA online at www.fafsa.gov. Dominican University’s school code: 001750. Students in the RN-BSN Program will need to complete the 2018 – 2019 FAFSA as well as the 2019 – 2020 FAFSA. Both FAFSAs are now available to complete.

2018-2019 FAFSA will require 2016 tax and income information to be reported.

2019-2020 FAFSA will require 2017 tax and income information to be reported.

Financial Aid Resources:

RN-BSN program students are eligible for federal student loans. Eligible students may also receive the Pell grant and MAP Grant. Scholarships will also be available.

	Annual Limit
Dependent Students	\$7,500 (up to \$5,500 can be subsidized)
Independent Students	\$12,500 (up to \$5,500 can be subsidized)

Your dependency status is determined by your answers to the dependency questions on the FAFSA. Dependent students will need to provide their parental information on the FAFSA. Independent students will be required to report their own income as well their spouse’s (if applicable).
