New Policies

- *Extensive Cleaning Procedures.
- *Toys are washed after each use.
- *Playground is cleaned between class usage.
- *Carpets are sprayed with disinfectant at the end of the day.
- *Staff, Students, and Caregivers temperatures taken upon entry.
- *Shoes changed upon arrival (send a second set of indoor shoes).
- *Masks at all times except during eating and sleeping and a cold drink of water outside.
- *Children are separated by 6ft during all meals and nap time.
- *Plexiglass Partitions have been created if 6ft can't be reached.
- *Hand washing during arrival, before and after each meals and nap, after all bathroom usage, and anytime the face or eyes are touched.
- *Parents are not allowed in the building. Children will enter their classrooms through each classrooms private exterior door.
- *Classes will not intermingle.



Goedert Care

As an Emergency Center since May 4th, we have been implementing extensive procedures to keep our students and staff safe and engaged. Working with the Department of Children and Family Services we designed policies and procedures that have been reviewed to ensure compliance. Furthermore, we have built out areas of our outdoor space to provide for more time outside in the fresh air.

In phases 3 & 4 of the stay at home order we will be here for you as you go back to work. Please give us at least one week's notice for your child's return. This will help us make sure we have everything for your child in place before they return.

Each morning before school please take a moment to check your child's temperature and assess them for any signs of cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain, soar throat, digestive issues, and lack of taste or smell . Children and staff will not be permitted with any of these symptoms. If you find that you have been exposed to Covid-19 contact the Illinois Department of Public Health at 217-782-2016. If we hear that a child has been exposed to Covid-19 and is attending our school we will immediately contact IDHP for guidance.
