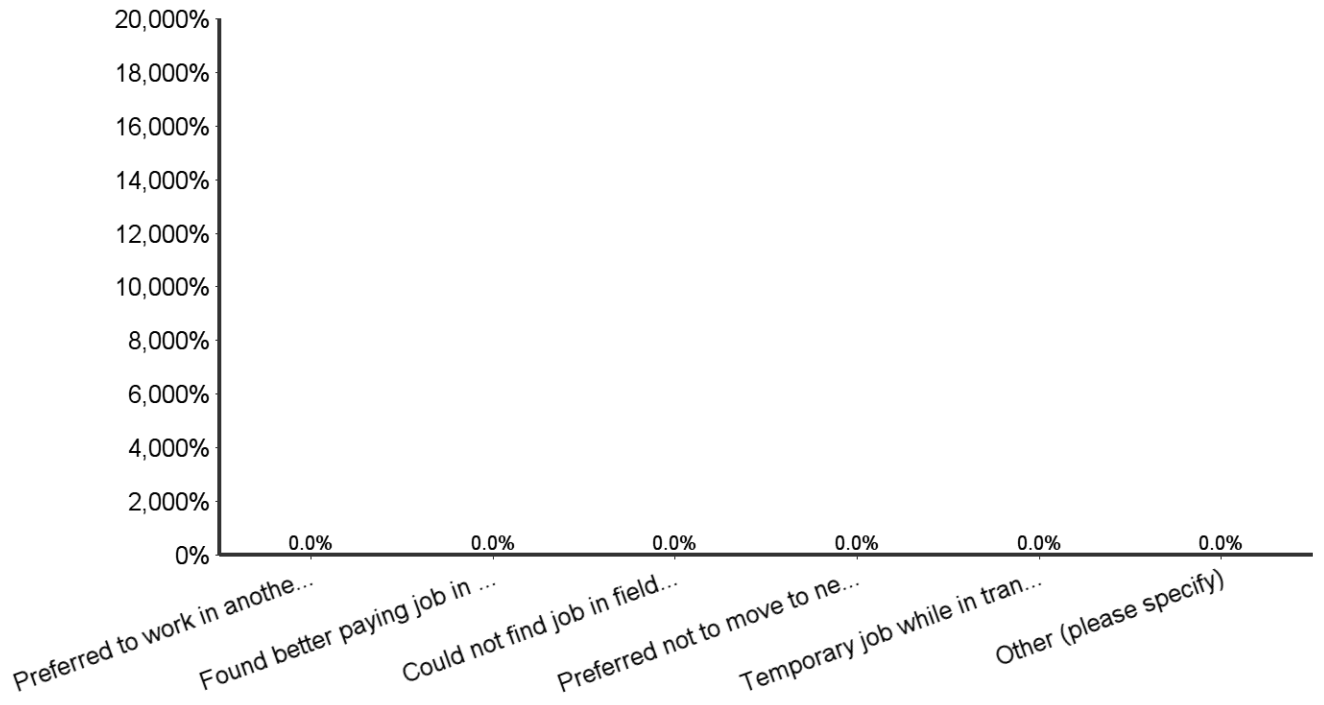

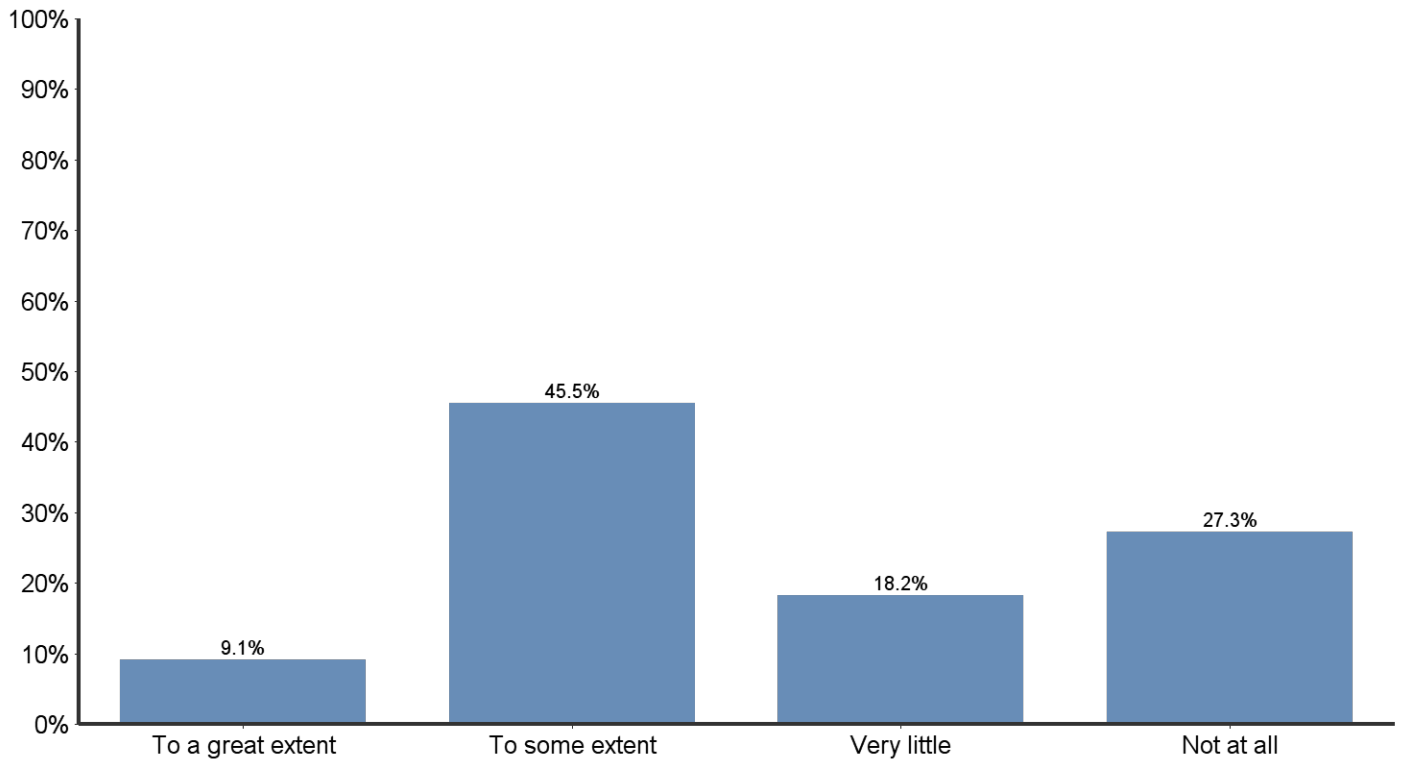

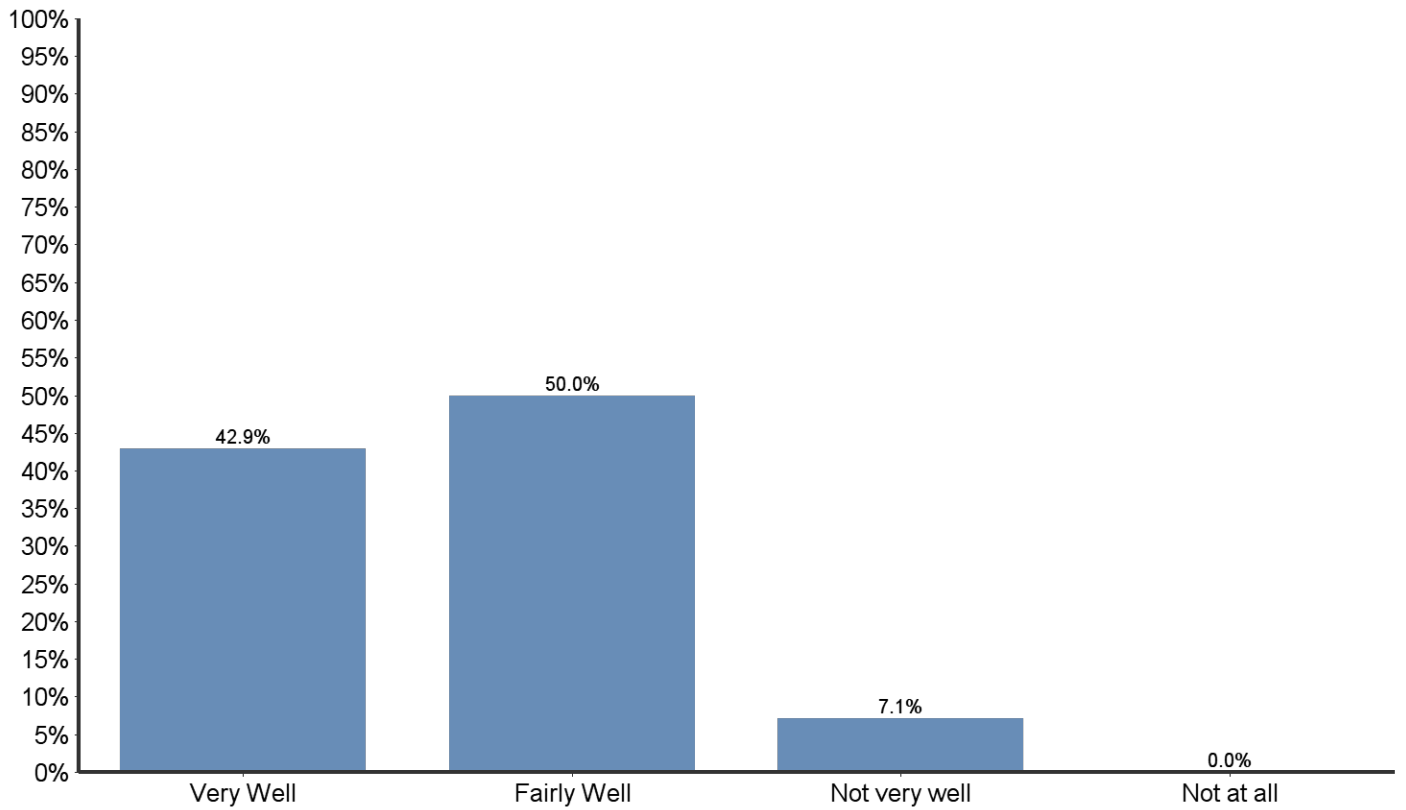
To what extent did Dominican assist you in finding a job?

Getting real life experiences from professors and really telling it how it is in the business world instead of sugar coating stuff. Also, professor Kiyosaki! He was a HUGE help!

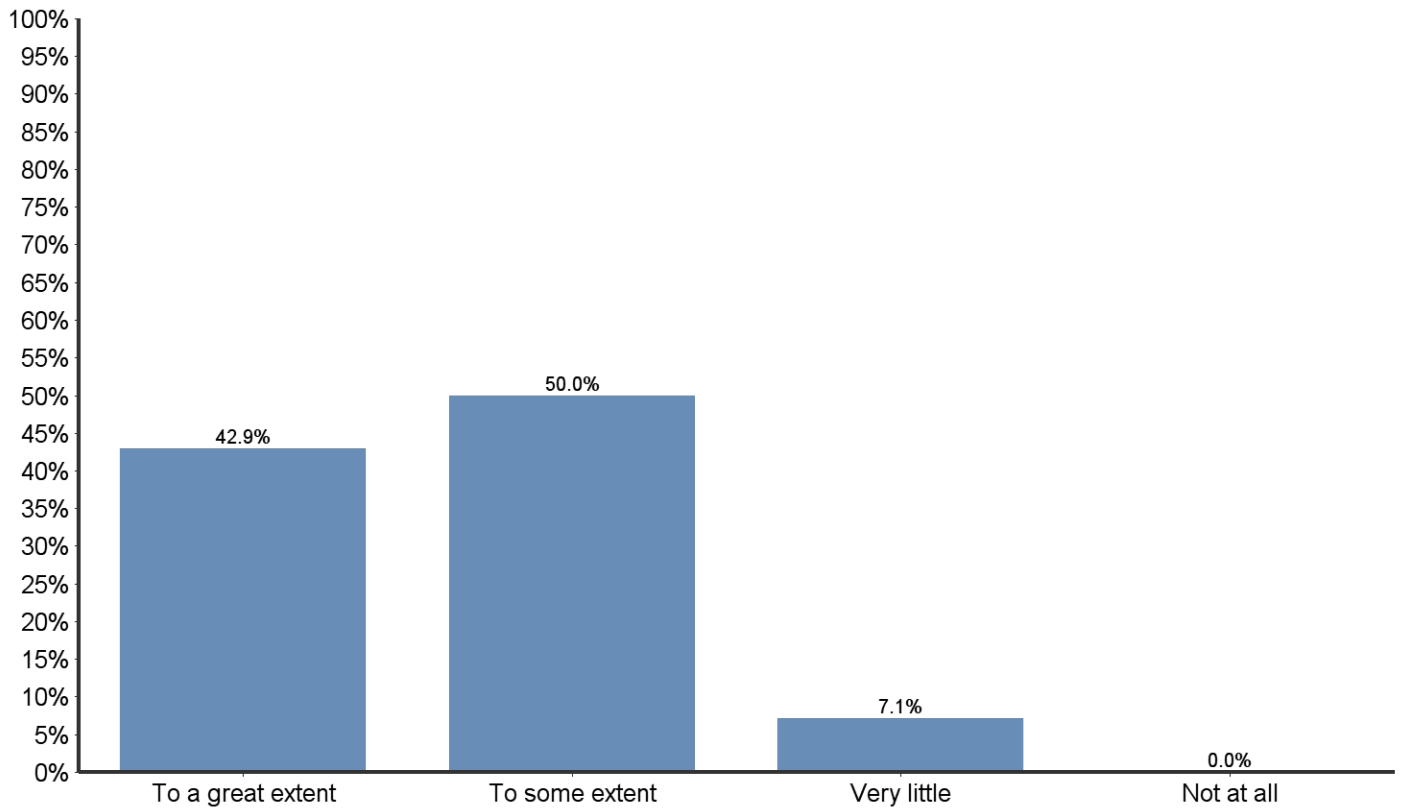

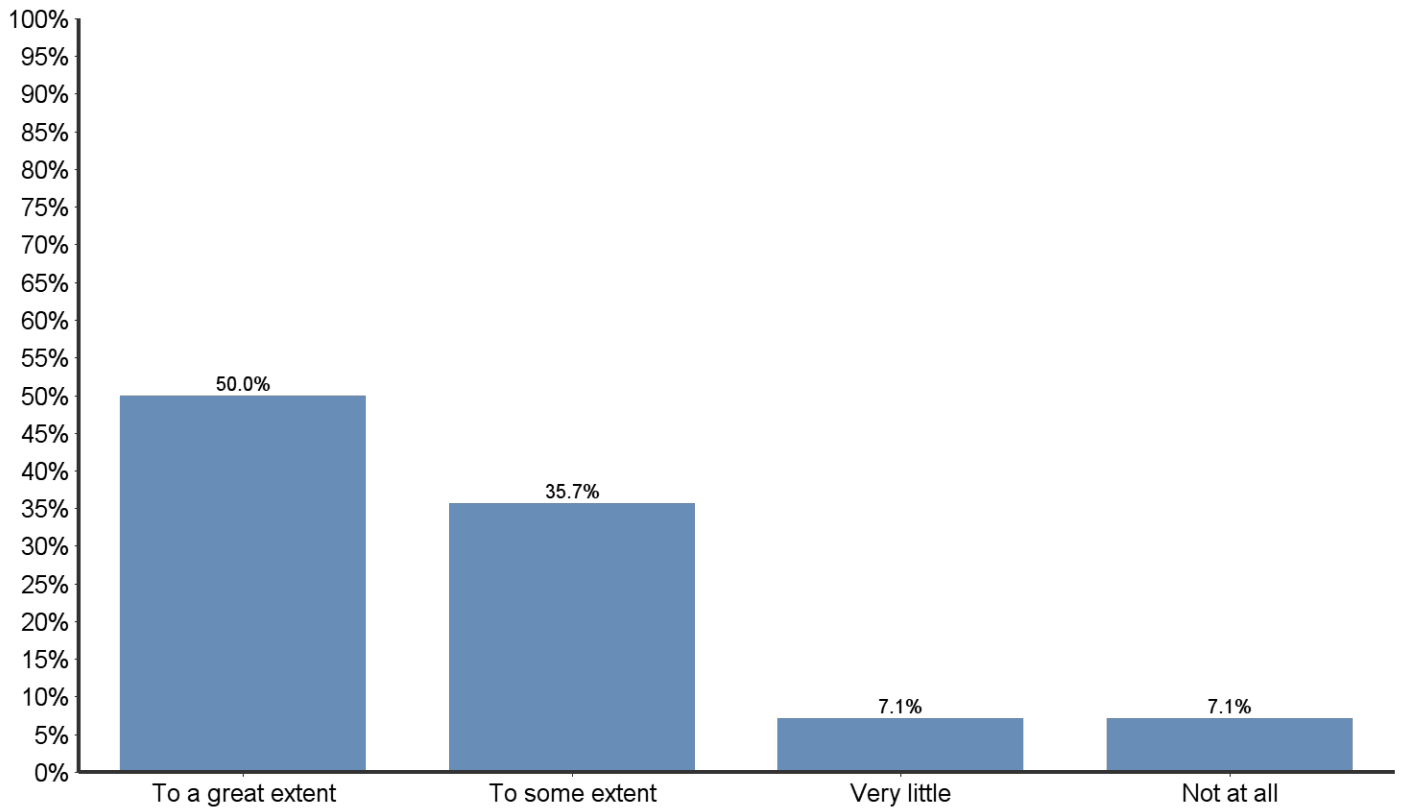
To what extent have you used the skills learned in your Dominican education in your current job?

To what extent has Dominican's mission (truth, service, justice) influenced your career activities?

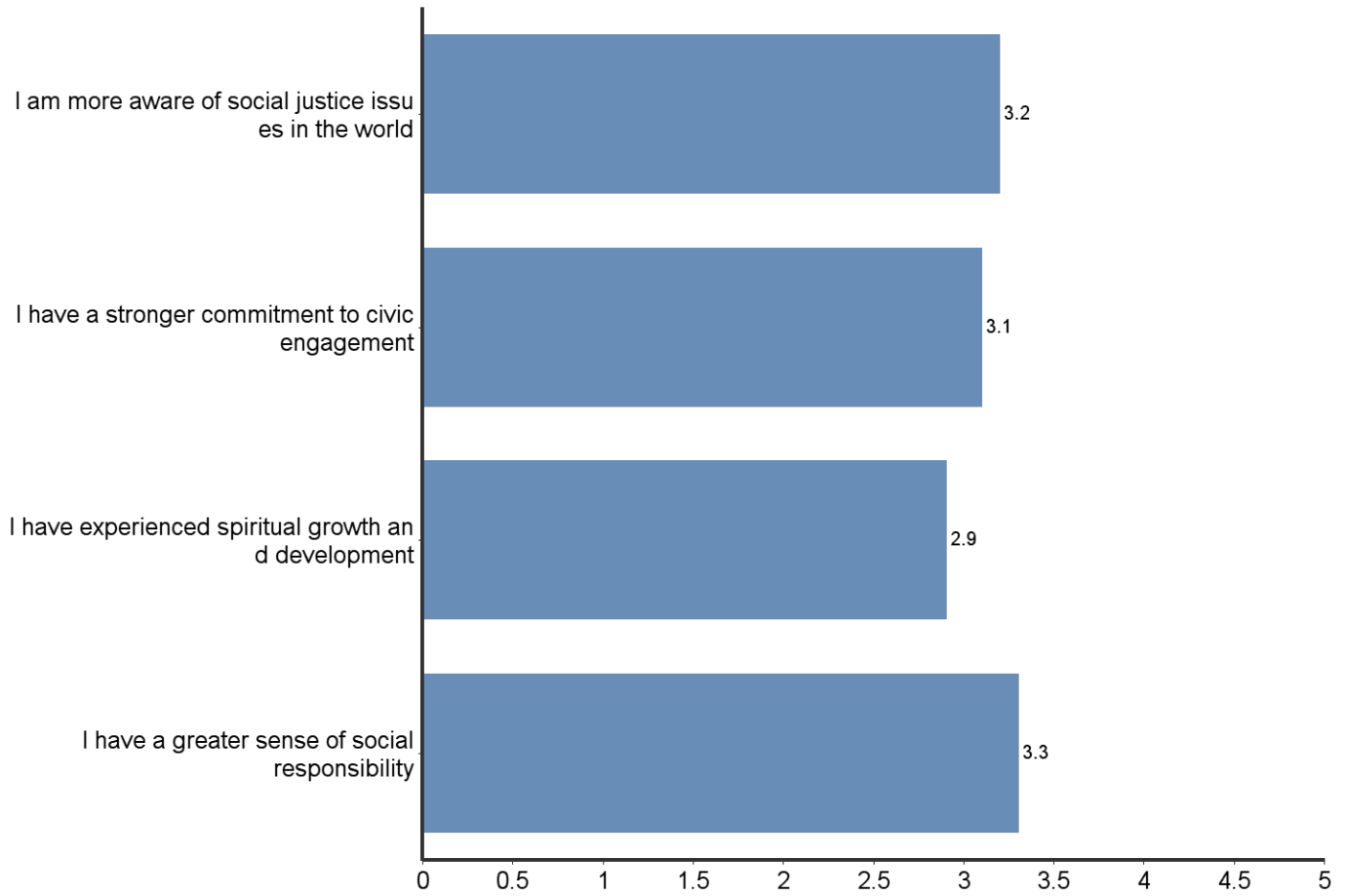

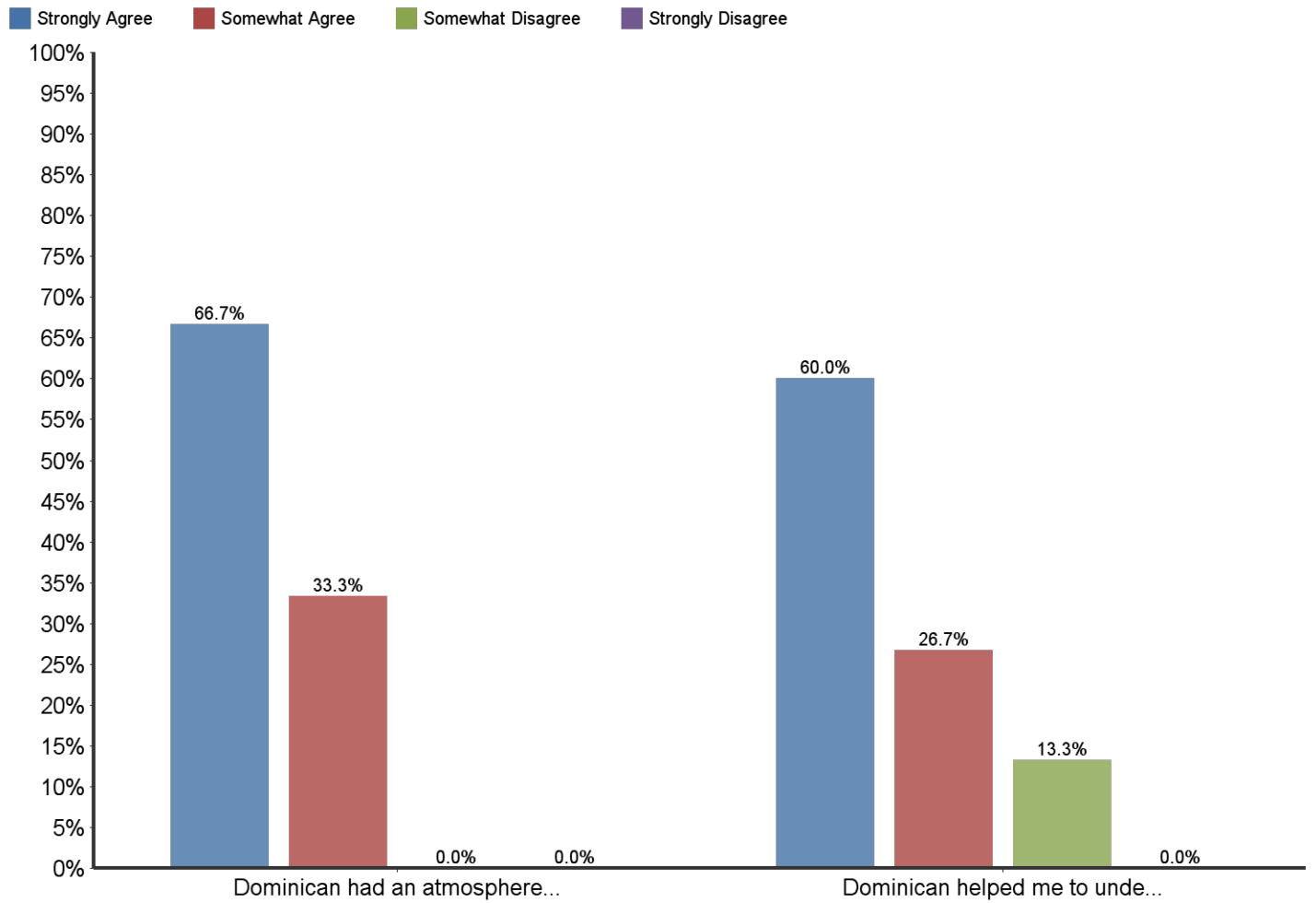

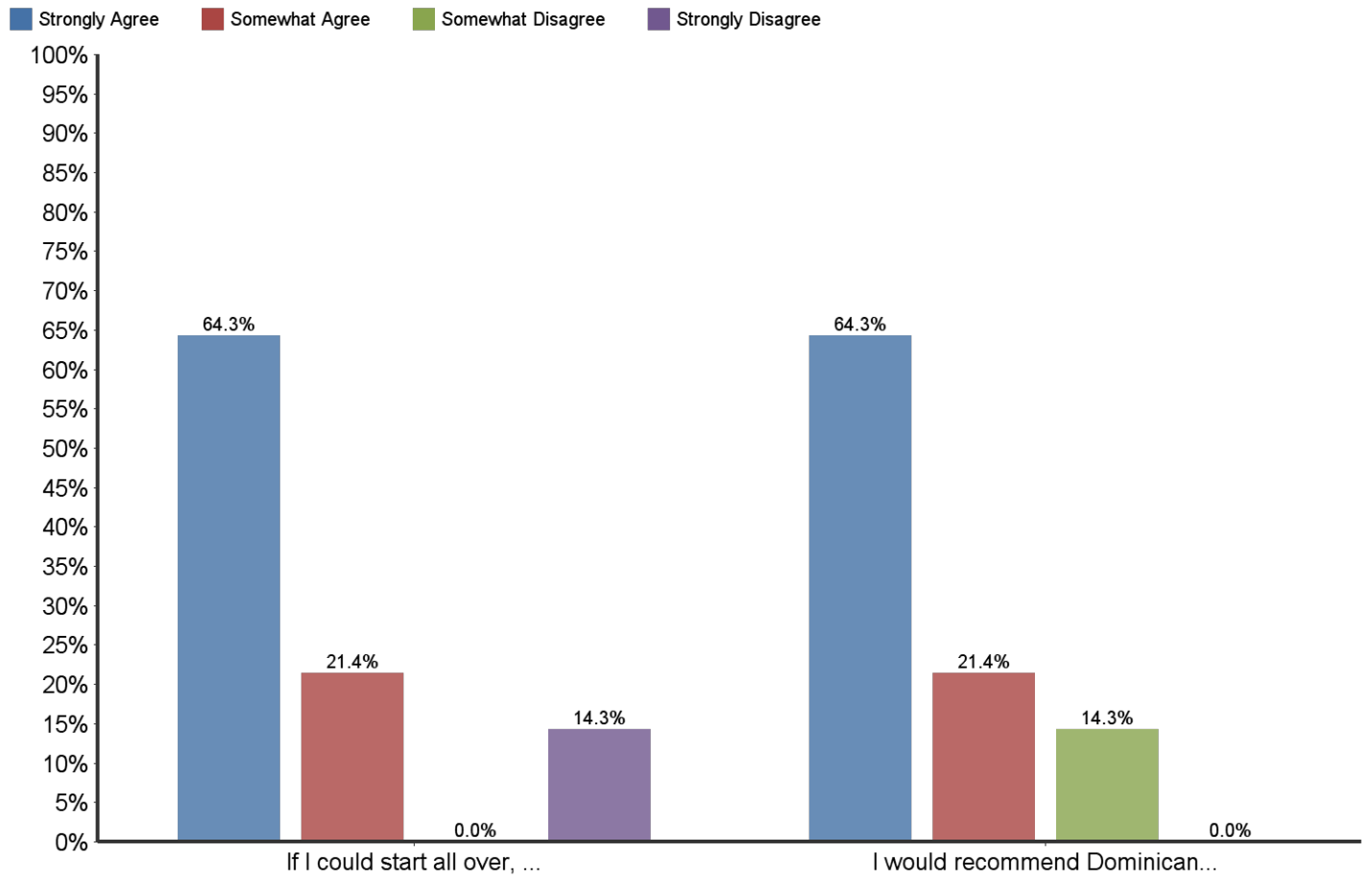
