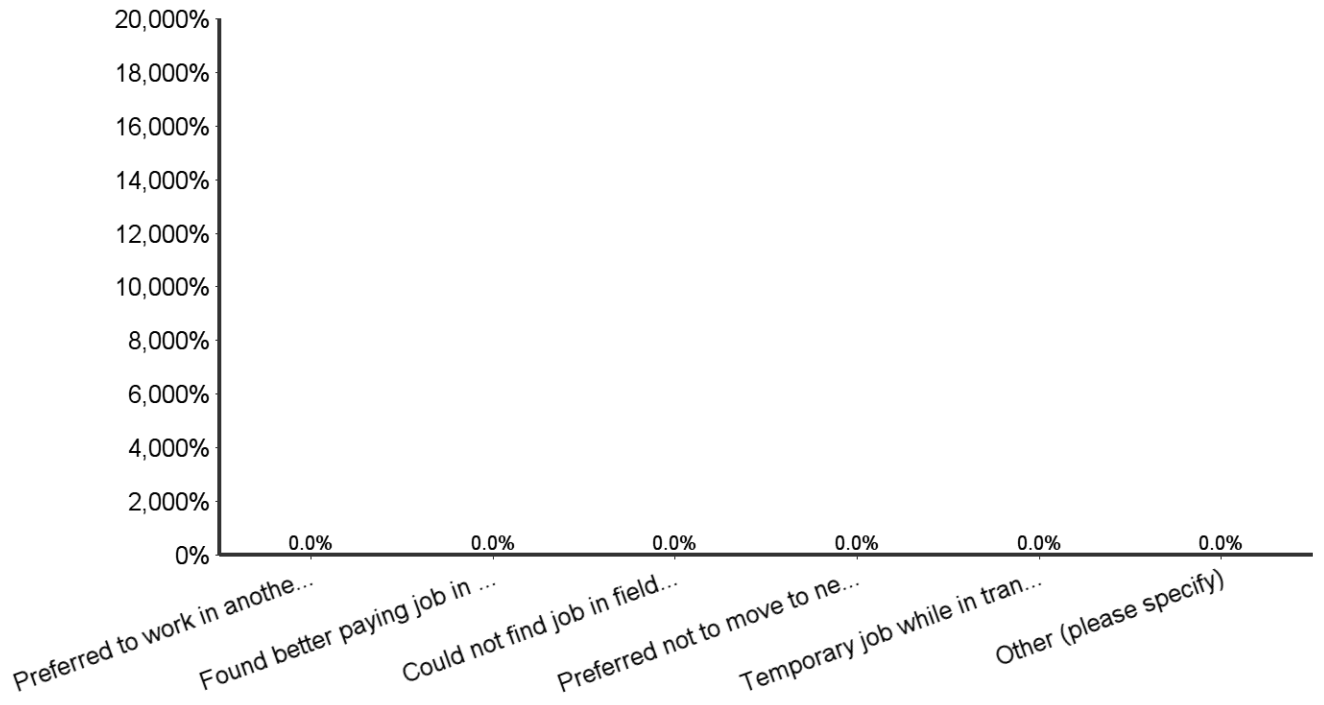

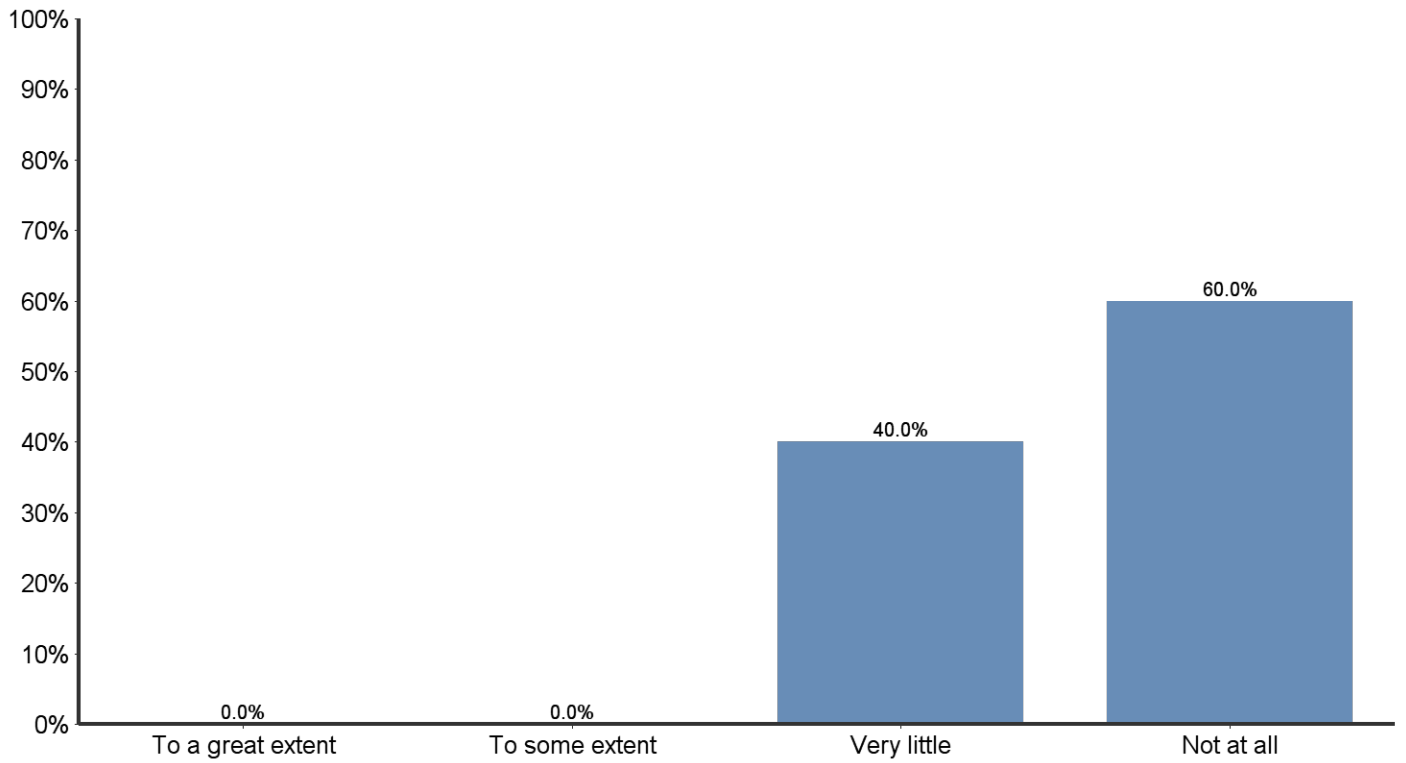

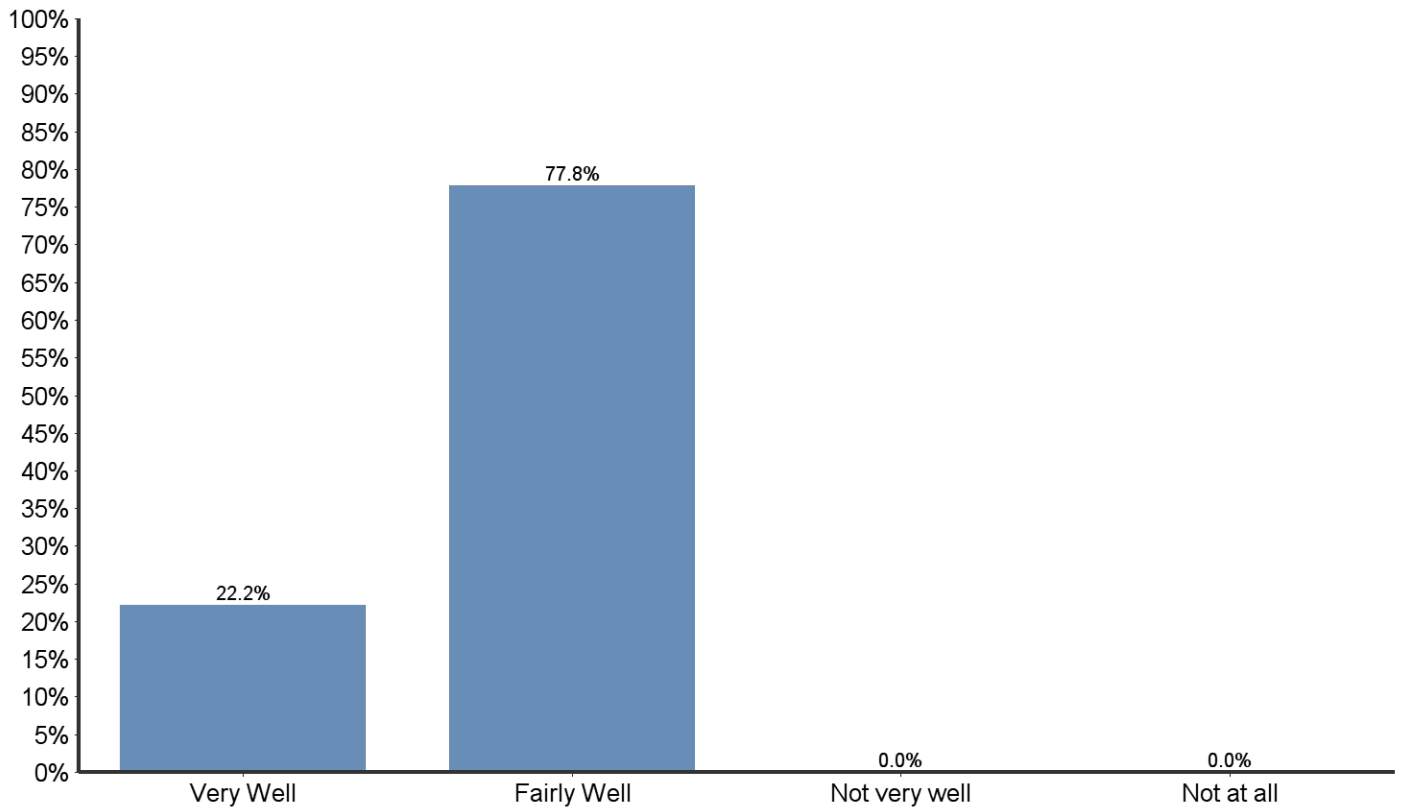
To what extent did Dominican assist you in finding a job?

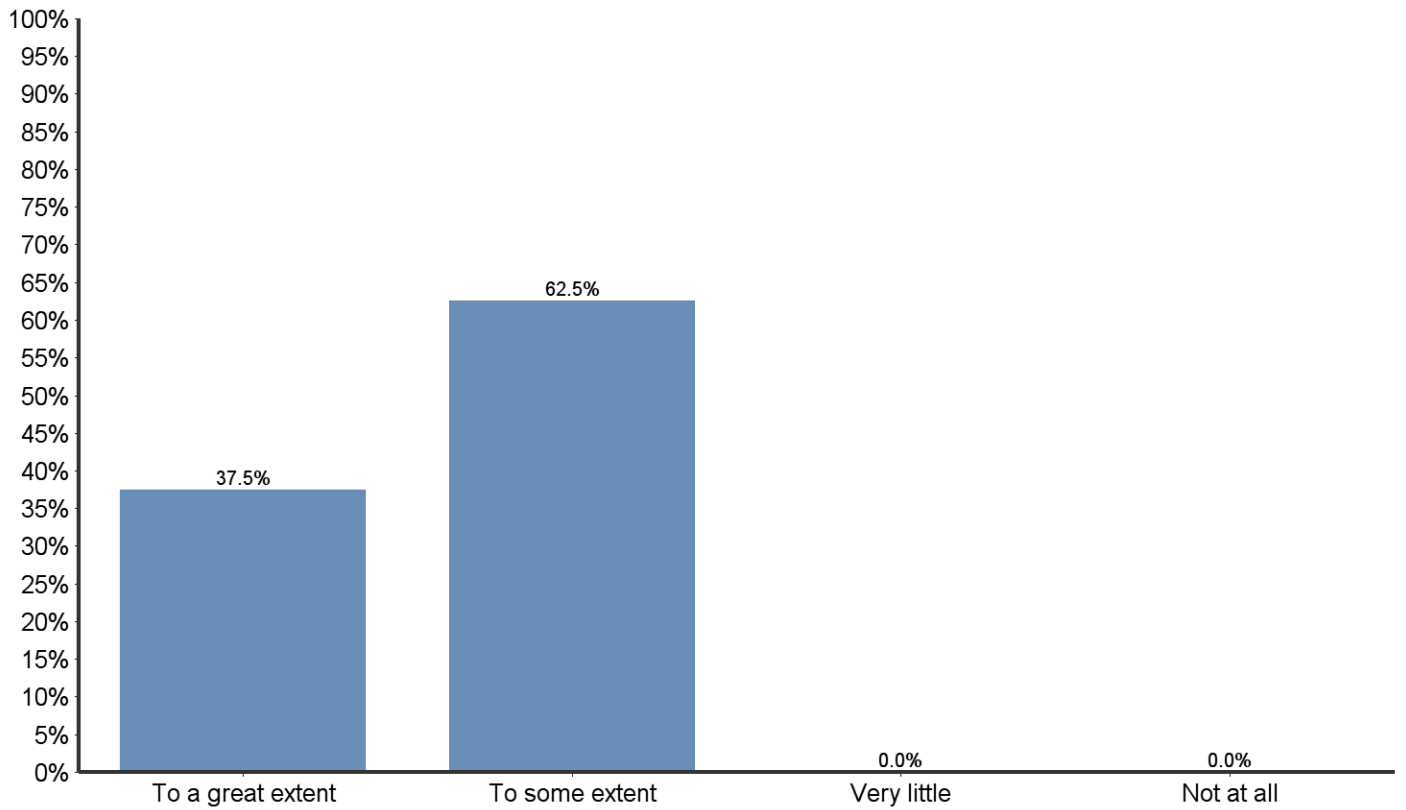
The ability to communicate in order to educate my customers regarding health eating and general well being. To critically assess current literature on dietary and lifestyle issues.

The professors were all very knowledgeable and always answered our questions relating to real life situations we were facing in the classroom. Our special education class that dealt with formal testing was also extremely informative.

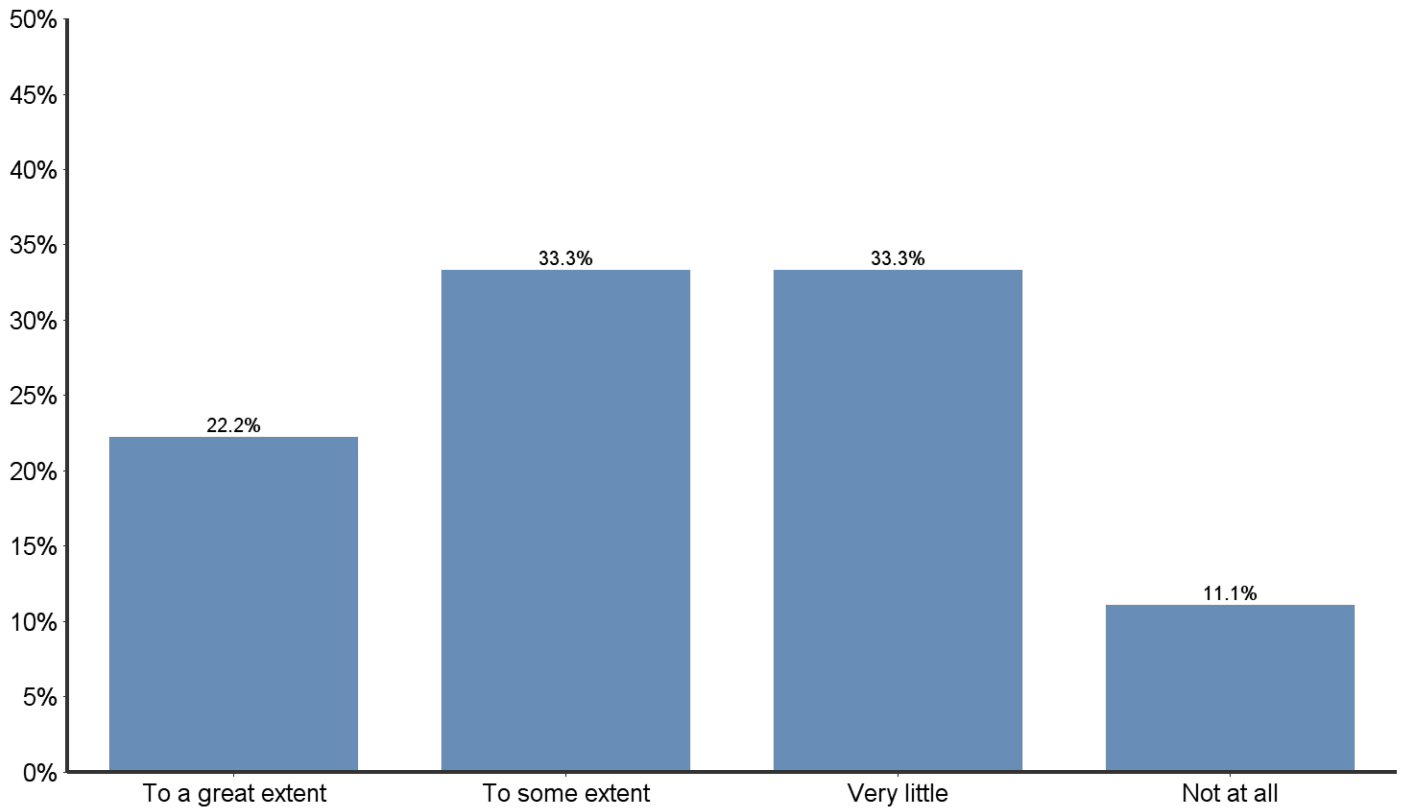
To what extent have you used the skills learned in your Dominican education in your current job?

To what extent has Dominican's mission (truth, service, justice) influenced your career activities?

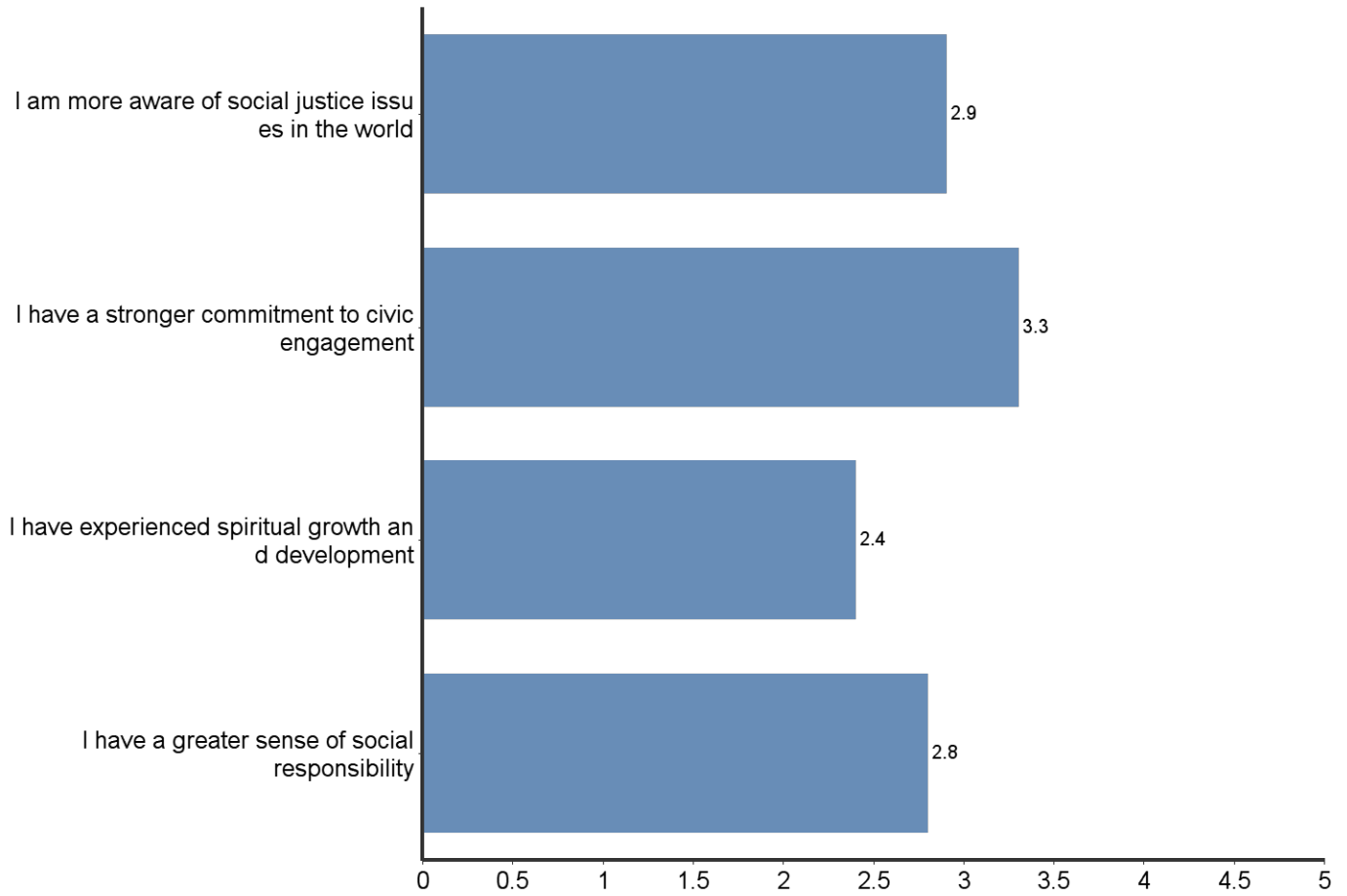

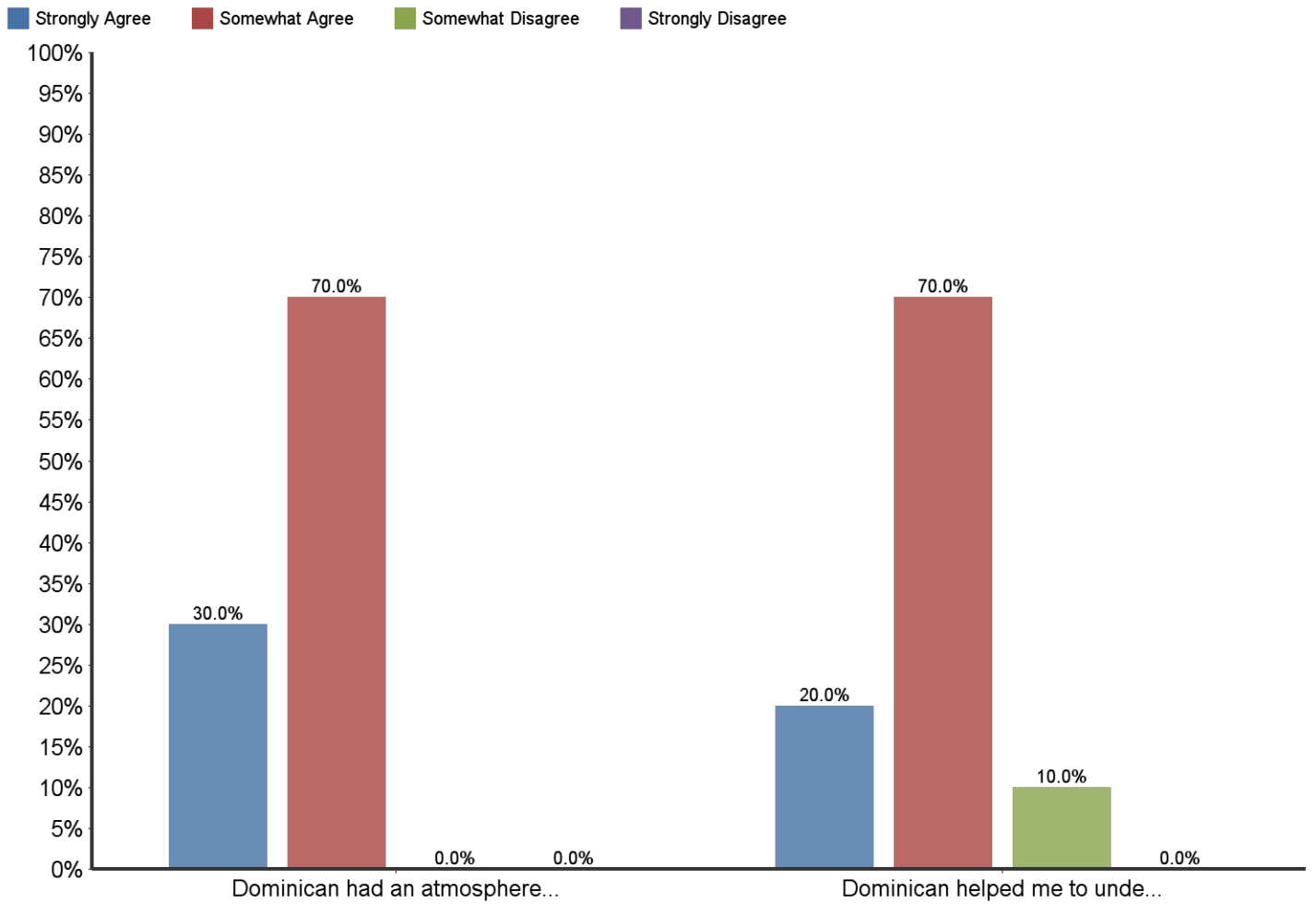

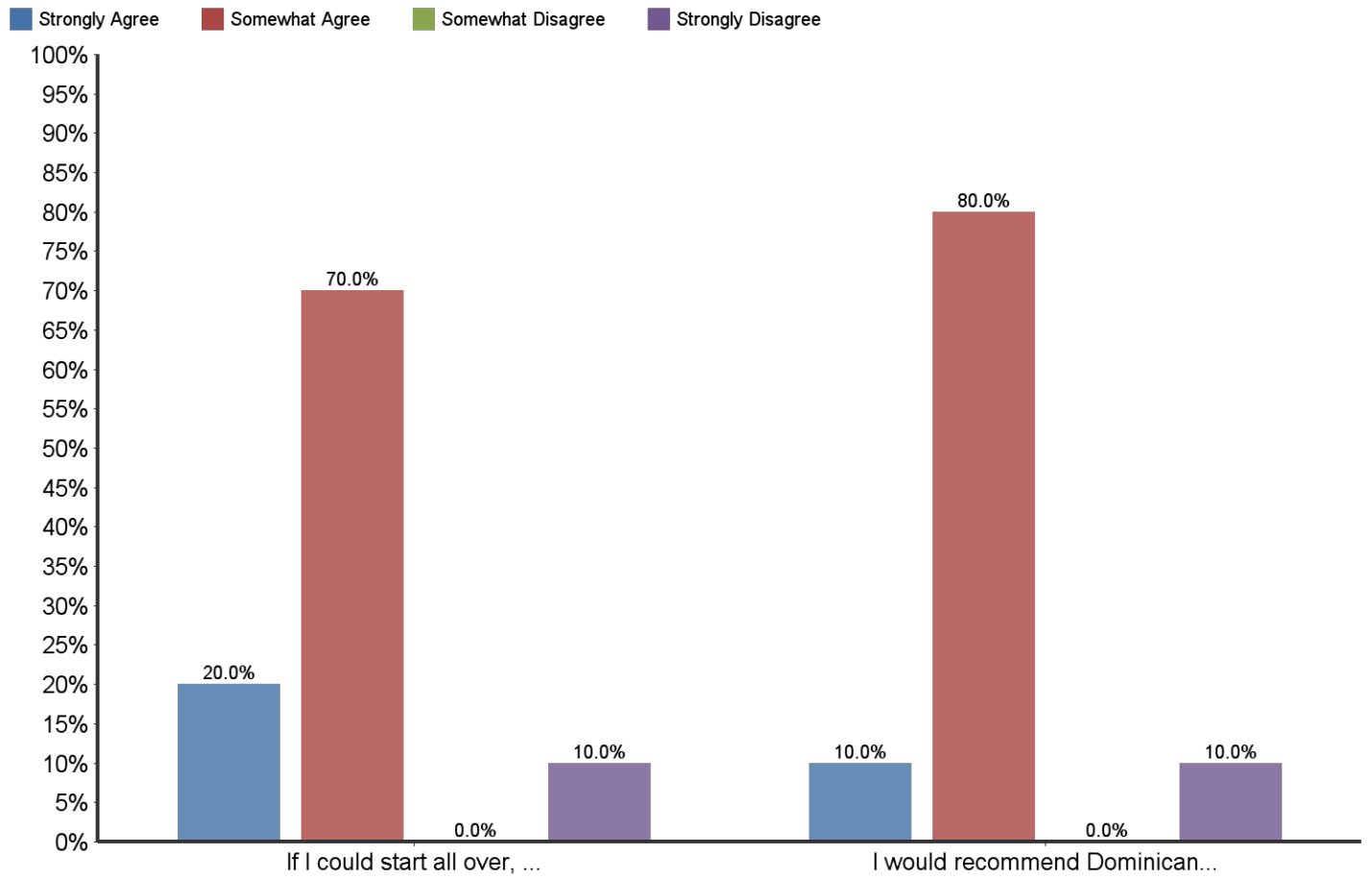

The only hesitation I have regarding recommending someone to Dominican is directly related to the somewhat chaotic environment that occurred after Dr. Hogan passed away. That was a very tragic event, especially having had her as a teacher and advisor, but being told our files weren't at school and not knowing if our graduation dates would be pushed back was not something that was ok. For the amount of money we were paying and the schedule that we had set, having unanswered questions as major as that was very concerning.

There was a huge problem with getting the Reading Specialist Certification where they told us we weren't going to be able to do it anymore. After a year of trying to find another university that would help me, they contacted Dominican and Dominican changed their minds. It was very inconvenient and frustrating.
