Reference inquiries it's what I spend the most time doing.




I will start my new job on November 1st, and am expecting to pull heavily from my degree and certificates.




I have a better sense of how what i do in a library setting can be detrimental or helpful for social justice issues.


Provided an environment to explore all sides of an issue and discuss how to implement positive change and sustain community partnerships.
